Actionable Points emerged during the review meeting on Disaster Management on 05.06.2009 at Raj Niwas.

- a) Chief Fire Officer to enforce fire safety provisions in all Godowns in Delhi and the matter may be examined for issue of suitable instructions in this regard.

Action : CFO

- ✓ b) All DCs were advised to minimize response time and keep a time log of responses by various agencies during any disaster/incident/mock drill.

Action : Divisional Commissioner

- ✓ c) A call out of Civil Defence volunteers at district level may be held once every six months to review their response & alertness and they be imparted refresher training on disaster management and be paid for such call-out-cum-trainings.

Action : Divisional Commissioner

- ✓ d) All concerned to adopt a proactive role in disaster management and stated that non-participation in District Disaster management Authority meetings by members shall be viewed seriously and proper departmental action shall be taken against them.

Action : Divisional Commissioner

- ✓ e) All factories involved in processing/manufacture of inflammable chemicals, offsite & onsite safety plans must be drawn up by the Factory Inspector and a copy each made available to the concerned SDM/DC.

Action : Labour Commissioner

- ✓ f) All Dy. Commissioners to prepare case studies of disaster in-terms of lessons learnt and steps to be taken for prevention and mitigation of disasters through augmented level of preparedness.

Action : Divisional Commissioner

- ✓ g) A sensitization programme for all private hospitals & Nursing Homes be organized and if Nursing Home fails to admit any causality, a case of criminal negligence can be filed. Supreme Court orders may be circulated.

Action : H&FW

- h) A dumping site in each of the districts for the debris may be identified by MCD.

Action : Commissioner, MCD

- ✓ i) Left lane of roads be vacated to give way to emergency vehicles & to start a campaign for giving way to emerg. vehicles. Each fire tender should've Global Positioning System & their real-time position should be available to Traffic police, DDMA, Fire Cont. Room.

Action : Jt. CP (T), Divisional Commissioner, CFO-DFS

- ✓ j) All DCs to examine enforcing provisions of Sec 133 Code of Criminal Provisions, 1973 with participation of MCD, Local SHO, Traffic Police & the community to clear encroachments.
