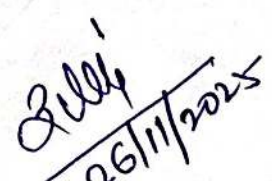

NOTICE

State Election Commission, NCT of Delhi has announced Bye-Elections to 12 Wards of the Municipal Corporation of Delhi namely Ward No. 35-Mundka, 56-Shalimar Bagh-B, 65-Ashok Vihar, 74-Chandni Chowk, 76-Chandni Mahal, 120-Dwarka B, 128-Dichaon Kalan, 139-Naraina, 163-Sangam Vihar-A, 164 Dakshin Puri, 173-Greater Kailash, 198-Vinod Nagar scheduled to be held on 30.11.2025 (Sunday). Subsequently, Joint Secretary, State Election Commission, GNCTD vide letter No. F.10(19)/SEC/E-1/2025/Pt. File/21522 dated 12.11.2025 has requested issuance of public notice regarding grant of paid holiday to electors working in various establishments in NCT of Delhi.
