The age limit for direct recruitment will be relaxable in the case of Scheduled Castes/Tribes candidates and other special categories of persons in accordance with the general orders issued from time to time by the Central Government.

2.

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

3.

No male candidate who has more than one wife living or no female candidate who has married a person already having a wife living shall be eligible for appointment in case of direct recruitment provided that the Administrator, Delhi may after being satisfied that there are special grounds for doing so, exempt any such candidate from the operation of this rule.

4.

Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may by order for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any person/class or category of persons/posts.
