- Notes:
1. The age limit for direct recruitment will be relaxable in the case of Scheduled Castes/Tribes candidates and other special categories of persons in accordance with the general orders issued from time to time by the Central Government.
 2. Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
 3. No male candidate who has more than one wife living or no female candidate who has married a person already having a wife living shall be eligible for appointment in case of direct special grounds for doing so, exempt any such candidate from the operation of this rule.
 4. Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to a class or category of persons/posts.

Col.No.6 Contd.-

NOTE: The crucial date for determining the age limit shall, be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh, Divisions of J & K State, Lahaul & Spiti district and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba district and Himachal Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar islands or Lakshdweep).

Col.12 contd.-

(The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/department of the Central Govt. shall ordinarily not exceed 3 years).
